Instructions

Your child has had a recent head injury.

You should return to your Doctor immediately if your child has any of the following:

- Frequent vomiting
- Bleeding or discharge from the ear or nose
- Severe or persistent headache
- A fit or spasms of the face or limbs
- Unusual or confused behaviour
- Difficulty in waking up
